With the help of people like you we have been able to :

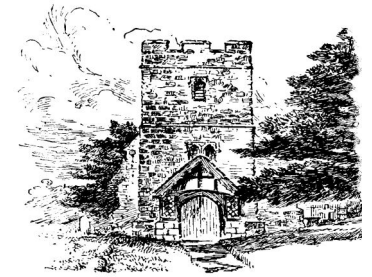
- Help with the repair of the Church Clock in Leeds
