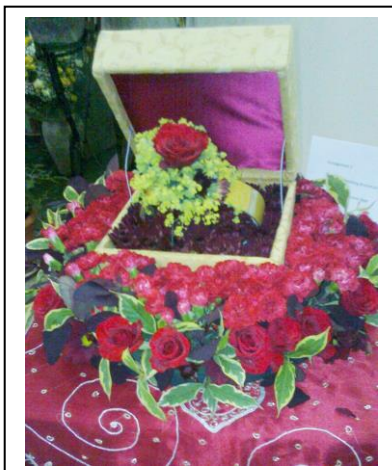


100th Anniversary of the Battle of the Somme, arranged by Gillian Gray
