The Friends, as a purely parish-bound charity, can appeal to about 800 local households; so there is plenty of scope for adding new members.

After fourteen years at £6 we decided to increase our annual subscription to £12 for new members. We hope existing members will increase their annual contributions too. A Standing Order Amendment form is included in this newsletter. Each year our regular subscribing members produce an annual income above £2,500 to which is added the profits from our events.

For this most generous support from members, our charity is very grateful indeed.
